Flying Wild is geared to Middle School Grades, but many activities are adaptable up and down, including a series of student-led activities that can be presented by middle-school students to elementary grade learners.

With over 40 student-tested, standards-based activities from Adaptation Artistry to Bird Olympics, Flying WILD provides interactive, interdisciplinary real-world learning that engages students in understanding the importance of birds and their conservation.

Topics range from basic bird biology, identification and ecology, to bird conservation service-learning activities. The program promotes greater environmental stewardship through monitoring projects and exciting bird festivals that are organized by the students for their friends, school or community, as well as in the classroom.

Flying WILD was developed under the guidance of environmental education professionals and wildlife conservation organizations. Flying WILD activities have been field tested in classrooms across the nation.

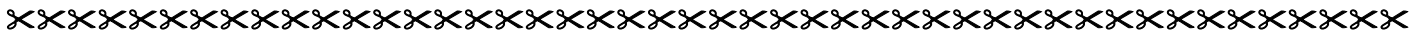
